



Electives Policy

Electives rotations allow students to acquire more experience in areas of their interest. IMDC supports clinical electives at IDH to internal as well as external students.

Internal students (IMDC Students applying for Electives):

1. Electives are encouraged during vacations however; they are not mandatory.
2. The students are to arrange their own electives placements external to the IMDC affiliate hospitals. However, the College will offer all documentary assistance necessary.
3. Students desirous of electives at IDH may apply through the department of student affairs. Further information is available from the department of student affairs
4. The students can write to the Department of Student Affairs to initiate their request for electives. All necessary documentation will be provided by the student affairs department
5. The students, on their return, must inform the Department of Student Affairs regarding their elective's placement (place of electives, start & end dates, electives supervisor)
6. Students are encouraged to form connections at the place of under taking their elective to ensure that other students of the College can also benefit from their experience.

External students (External students applying for electives at IMDC):

1. The institute will not allow a foreign dental graduate or Pakistani student studying dentistry at foreign institute unless registered with PM&DC as foreign student for the period of elective. (As per PM&DC policy)
2. Electives are offered in all clinical departments.
3. Student/doctor will apply to the Department of Student Affairs/HR by submitting the application form for electives. (Copy attached).
4. IDH will not be responsible for providing or arranging boarding facilities to elective students. Student/doctor will be responsible for their own food and medical coverage.
5. The elective placement must be approved by the Principal/Project Director.
6. Student/doctor will report to the HOD of the respective department.
7. Although every effort would be made to make the elective an enjoyable experience, the College and/or Hospital would not be held liable for any mishap, experience and events that may directly or indirectly, physically or emotionally harm the elective student on or off the college or hospital premises during the course of the elective.
8. Upon completion of the elective(s) the certificate will be generated after recommendation of the concerned HOD.
